2. <u>Discussion regarding Strategy related to Collective Bargaining with the Custodians and Food Service Workers, pursuant to M.G.L. c.30A, §21(a)(3):</u>

Susan Bottan requested authorization from the School Committee to allow her to engage in collective bargaining with the Food Service workers for a one-year contract. Susan explained the changes that will be negotiated in the contract, including a 2% COLA at an estimated total cost of \$8,200, an additional step, alignment of the number of personal days with the WESA contract, and a change in the hourly catering rate. Susan referred to the Edvocate Report in terms of implementing recommendations made in that report for the Food Service Program.

Upon a motion duly made by Barb Fletcher, seconded by Kathie Steinberg, the School Committee voted to authorize Susan Bottan to enter into negotiations with the Food Service workers for a one-year contract through 2017, a 2% COLA, one additional step, 2 personal days, and a time and a half catering hourly rate.
