Other negotiable terms include bonuses, benefits, sick leave, vacation buy back, subscriptions to educational materials, and notice of termination.

Ellen will contact Dr. Unobskey again regarding the revisions to the contract, all of which School Counsel will review. This discussion will resume at the School Committee's next meeting.
